On March 11th, 2021 the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 (ARP) was passed in part to distribute funds to institutions of higher education in order to prevent, prepare for, and respond to coronavirus through HEERF. The HEERF funding is required to go directly to students in emergency financial aid grants for any component of the student's cost of attendance or for emergency costs that arise due to coronavirus, such as tuition, food, housing, health care (including mental health care) or child care.
