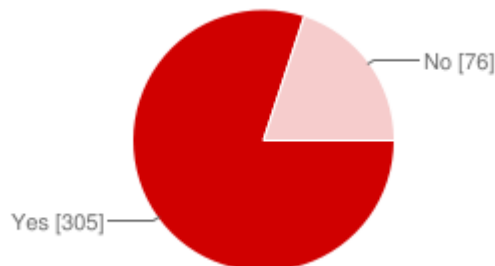

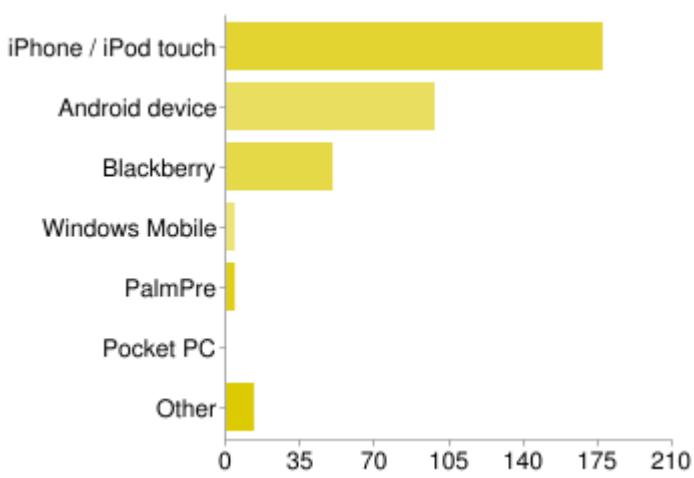

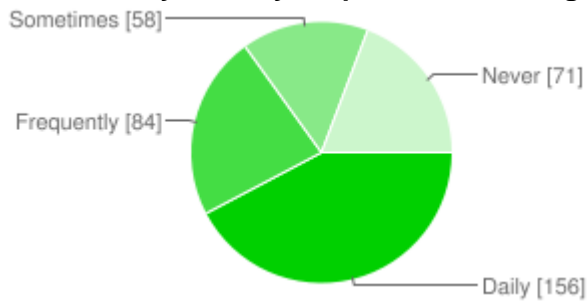

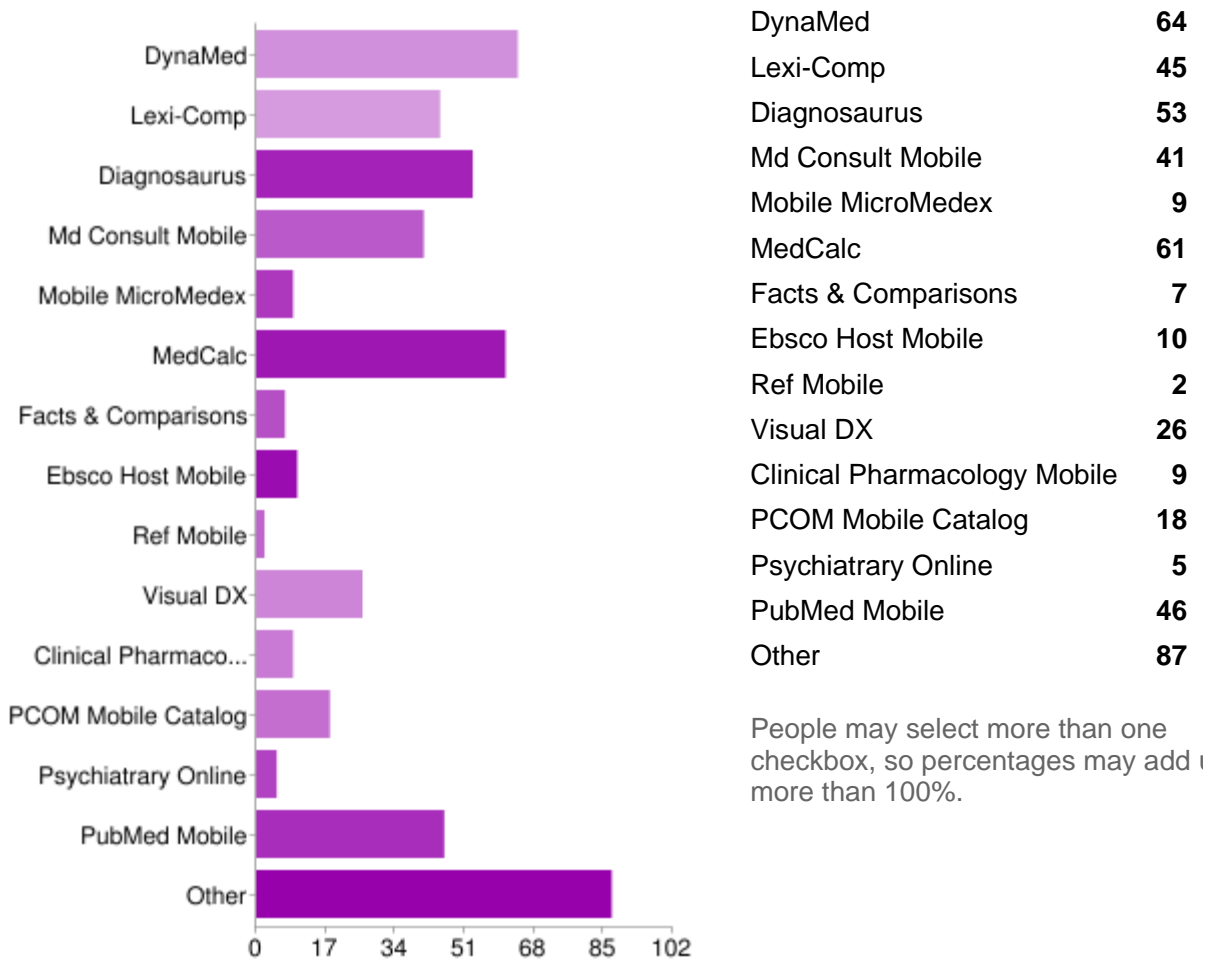

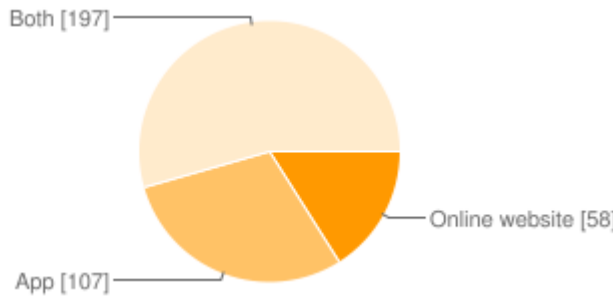

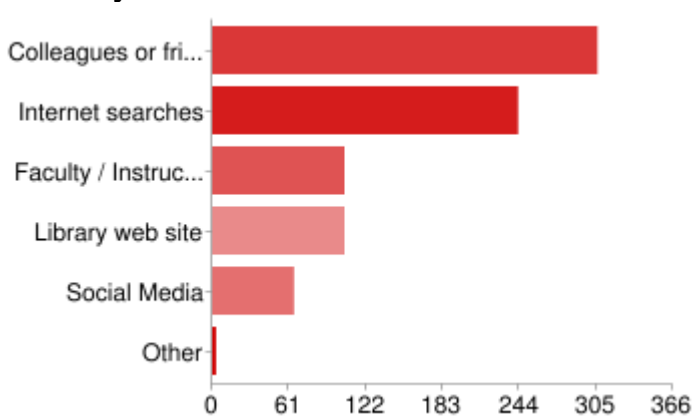


**Do you prefer to search an online website, download an app, or both?**



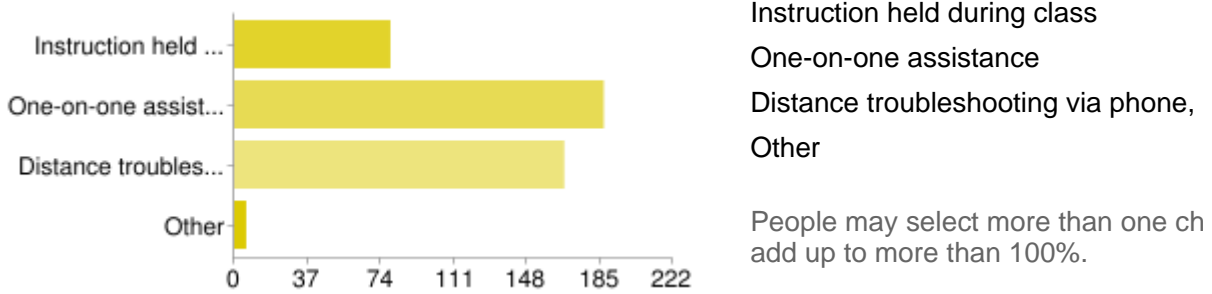

**How do you find new information tools and resources?**

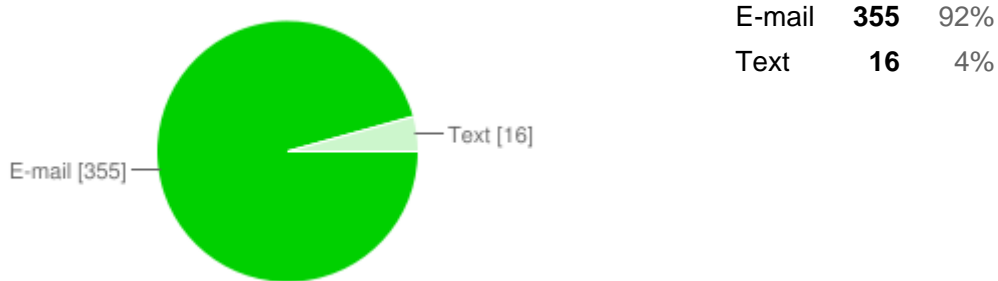
