

## What is PCOM OneSearch?

PCOM OneSearch is an online tool that allows you to simultaneously search the PCOM catalog and almost 50 licensed databases. It is a discovery tool; you will no doubt find valuable information in databases and collections you do not routinely search.

## What are the advantages of using OneSearch?

In addition to offering simultaneous search capability and exposure to new resources, OneSearch supports searching of databases by nine broad categories (Alternative Medicine, Behavioral Sciences, Education, Medicine & Health Sciences, and others). When you apply a category filter, you are searching in databases identified by library staff as particularly relevant to that area of interest.

## How do I search?

Enter search terms and criteria (keyword, title, author, etc), and how they should be combined (And/Or). Limit by date if desired. Select a Subject Category.

## How do search results display?

The default display is grouped by database. Databases that return results faster appear at the top of the list. Depending upon the search, the database display will vary.

## When I display by relevancy, how can I tell what database the result is from?

Source information is usually indicated at the end of a citation. When you have printed your results or finished viewing them, closing a database will return you to the initial results list. This list will display the title of the article/image viewed and the database in which it is located.

As well as the basic bibliographic information, each record includes index terms using the AMED Thesaurus and an abstract summarizing the article being cited.

### Why do some databases display more results than others?

Each database has its own display default. Some databases may initially display 10 results, others 25. Clicking on "Next Set" will provide additional results if available.

### Why isn't every database available for combined searching?

OneSearch's ability to search many databases at the same time requires that each of them have special search programming; not all databases have this feature. You can still search individual databases directly, by clicking on the link to that database and searching on the site itself.

**Why do I need to enter my Network User ID and Password to see the results in OneSearch from off- campus?**

Most licensing restrictions set by databases vendors focus on authenticating users as valid members of the licensing institution. By entering your User ID and Password, the system can verify that you are a member of the PCOM community.
