## FAST FACTS

PCOM South Georgia, an additional location of Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine, offers the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine degree and the Master of Science in Biomedical Sciences degree.

Situated on 31 acres in Moultrie, Georgia, a city of about 14,000 people in Southwest Georgia, the campus features a 75,000-square-foot facility completed in August 2019. The building includes expansive classrooms, study spaces, modern osteopathic manipulative medicine and anatomy labs, a Simulation Center, numerous exam and practice rooms, a dining area, information commons and a large outside courtyard for gathering and studying.

## FOCUS

PCOM South Georgia enrolled its first class in 2019 in response to the acute need for more healthcare providers to serve the growing population of Georgia and the surrounding states. The College encourages graduates to serve in rural areas with severe physician shortages.

## FOUNDED IN 1899,

Philadelphia College of Osteopathic Medicine (PCOM) extended its commitment to the Southeast by establishing PCOM South Georgia, an additional teaching location in Moultrie, Georgia. PCOM South Georgia offers both a full, four-year medical program leading to the Doctor of Osteopathic Medicine (DO) degree and a Master of Science in Biomedical Sciences degree. PCOM is a private, not-for-profit institution which trains professionals in the health and behavioral sciences fields. Joining PCOM Georgia in Suwanee in helping to meet the healthcare needs of the state, PCOM South Georgia focuses on educating physicians for the South Georgia region. The medical campus, which welcomed its inaugural class of medical students in August 2019, has received accreditation from the American Osteopathic Association's Commission on Osteopathic College Accreditation.
