## OBJECTIVE

Upon completion of this program, participants should be able to:

- Understand difference between addiction and physical dependence.
- Recognize need for balance in use of controlled substances for treatment of pain.
- Explain federal laws and Pennsylvania regulations related to prescribing of medical marijuana.
- List possible routes of administration.
- Describe therapeutic uses.
- Discuss pharmacokinetics (e.g., how delta-9-tetrahydrocannabinol [delta-9-THC] is retained in the body), pharmacodynamics, adverse effects, potential drug interactions and clinical indications.

- Identify methods of mitigating risk related to utilization of medical marijuana with respect to federal laws and regulations.
- Anticipate, be able to identify, and mitigate potential physiological and psychological adverse effects of marijuana.
