PCOM's School Psychology and Applied Behavior Analysis programs now offer students the opportunity to apply for supervised **pediatric behavioral health practicums** through PCOM Psychological Services and the PCOM Healthcare Centers.

FOR THOSE READY TO MAKE AN IMPACT

Students selected for these placements:

- » Work as part of a team that provides psychoeducational evaluation and/or functional behavioral assessment services to adolescents and children
- » Have the opportunity to provide consultation and short-term intervention support to parents and guardians related to youth learning and behavioral concerns at PCOM healthcare centers
- » Consult directly with school personnel to provide school-based consultative and behavioral services

UNDERSTANDING THAT LEADS TO BETTER OUTCOMES

Developmental, behavioral, and learning needs addressed include:

- » Following directions
- » Tantrums, aggression and self-injury
- » Neurodevelopmental concerns (e.g., ADHD and Autism)
- » Sleep hygiene
- » Feeding concerns
- » Toileting concerns
- » Social relationships
- » Academic concerns at home and school
- » Special Education
- » Communication between home and school

Supervision is provided by licensed psychologists, school psychologists, and/or Board Certified Behavior Analysts (depending on the program in which the student is enrolled). The assessment, consultative, and treatment modalities provided are predominantly behavioral, consistent with ABA and CBT approaches.
